FRIENDS

Attending Physician

Directs the patient's medical care and develops the plan of care with the interdisciplinary team.

Registered Nurse

Available to address symptom management and comfort care needs 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

ian Medical Director

Co-certifies terminal prognosis. Assists in guidance and medical oversight of the plan of care.

Grief Care Services

Provides guidance for patients and their family to help navigate anticipatory grief as well as offer support in the months following a loss.

Hospice Aide

Assists the patient with hygiene, feeding, bathing and similar personal care activities as determined by the plan of care.

Volunteer

Provides assistance and friendship while offering compassionate, emotional support to the patient.

Social Worker

Assists the patient and their family in bridging loved ones together and matching their needs with community resources.

Spiritual Support

Joins the patient and family to provide support consistent with their beliefs and available to make community connections as desired.
