

LEVELS OF CARE

ROUTINE CARE - Routine home care is provided per an individualized plan of care, wherever the patient calls home. Supplies, durable medical equipment and medications related to the hospice diagnosis are included.

RESPITE CARE - Respite is short-term inpatient care provided to a patient which allows family members to take a vacation or attend to other family responsibilities. Patients can receive care at one of our many contracted facilities.

CONTINUOUS CARE - This care is provided by a full-time care team for relief and control of acute pain and symptom crisis wherever the patient calls home.

INPATIENT CARE - This care is transitional care for acute pain and symptom management and is provided in an inpatient setting.
